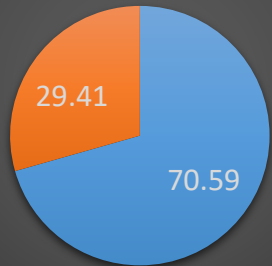
Aim

 - Reduce anti social behaviour



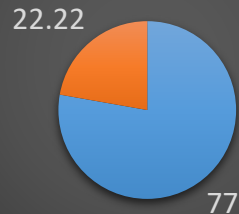
Evidence of need

would you or a relative use it



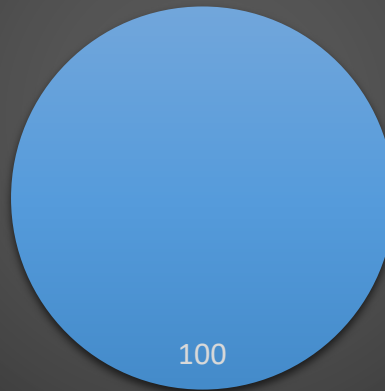
■ yes (70.59%) ■ no(29.41%)

should we charge a fee



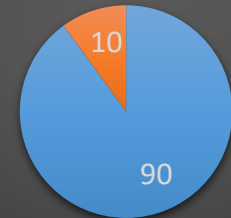
■ yes(77.78%) ■ no(22.22%)

Income:

22.5% of children u16 living in Mirehouse are in a low-income household, (Cumbria: 12.2%).

13.5% of these are from a single-parent low-income household, (Cumbria:7.9%)

15% of all children u16 in the Well Whitehaven are from a low-income household.

There are 290 children in the Well Whitehaven boundary living in a work benefit claimant household.
