

BYOD - Windows Laptop / Surface

1. Open the list of available WiFi networks and select 'BYOD'
2. For Identity / Username enter your school email address
3. For password enter your school account's password (NOTE: if you change your password you will need to edit the Network connection to reflect the change)
4. You should now be connected

Once connected you will need to install our Certificates in order to browse the internet without security warnings:

1. Open a web browser and in the address bar at the top – navigate to <https://cet-itservices.org/fortinet.cer>
2. A file download should start



3. You may get a warning saying 'this type of file can harm your device', if so, choose 'Keep' (you may need to mouse-over it and click the 3 dots to see the option)
4. Click 'Open file'
5. A box with a security warning will pop up, click 'Open'
6. Click 'Install Certificate...'
7. For store location choose 'Local Machine', if a user account control prompt comes up, close it off and choose 'Current user' instead.
8. Click the 'Place all certificates ...' Check box then click browse

Windows can automatically select a certificate store, or you can specify a location for the certificate.

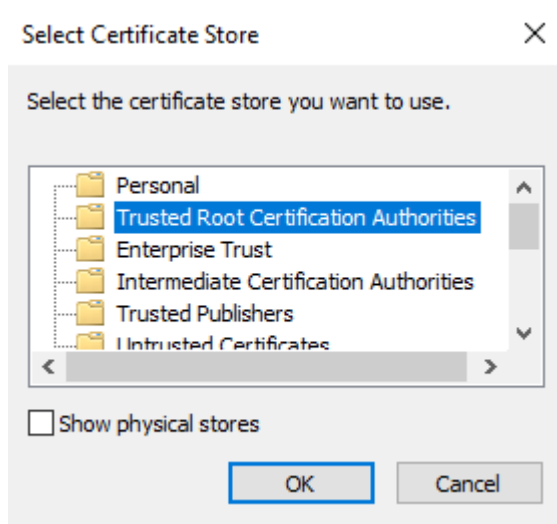
Automatically select the certificate store based on the type of certificate

9. Choose 'Trusted Root Certification Authorities' and click OK.



10. Click Next – then finish – then OK. You should get a pop-up saying Import Successful

11. Repeat these steps for <https://cet-it-services.org/netsweeper.cert>

12. Close down and reopen any browsers you had open and you should now be able to surf the Web.
